

## MVR CANCER CENTRE & RESEARCH INSTITUTE CANCER SCREENING CAMP POLICY

## **Primary screening**

- The integral part of the camp is a primary screening procedure. Primary screening will consist of a survey among the target population pertaining to the signs and symptoms of cancer which is to be conducted by health volunteers.
- Volunteers for conducting the survey are to be arranged by the organisers. Training for the volunteers will be done by consultants from MVRCCRI on a predetermined date.
- A list of subjects with suspected symptoms based on the survey are to be prepared by the organisers in consultation with the medical officer of the area. The list will be further scrutinised by MVRCCRI and a final list of eligible subjects for the camp will be prepared. Only subjects from the final list are to attend the camp.

## **Screening camp**

- The number of camps to be conducted will depend upon the final list of subjects selected for the camp and will be decided by MVRCCRI.
- Organisers have to arrange a suitable location for the camp in consultation with the coordinator from MVRCCRI.
- The consultation rooms and required furniture has to be arranged by the organisers. Separate consultation rooms are mandatory for males and females.
- Adequate privacy should be ensured in each consulting room with separate areas for consultation and examination of the patient. A separate room for taking Pap smear should also be arranged.

- The number of consultation rooms will depend on the number of subjects for the camps and will be decided by MVRCCRI.
- The required number of doctors and accompanying nursing staff will be arranged by MVRCCRI.
- All medical equipment needed for the camp will be arranged by MVRCCRI.
- Organisers are to ensure that there are sufficient volunteers to guide and facilitate the camp participants.
- All expenses related to the camp are to be borne by the organisers. Details of the same are given in the annexure.
- Mammography, USG, FNAC and Pap smear investigations will be done by MVRCCRI and the cost of the same has to be met by the organisers. Any subjects requiring other investigations will be advised by MVRCCRI and the same should be followed up by the organisers.
- All investigations will be done in the institution's mobile cancer screening unit "Wheels
  of Hope".
- Organisers to ensure that a flat spacious terrain to park the mobile cancer screening unit is made available.
- All participants of the camp should be followed up by the organisers and it should be ensured that the treatment or further evaluation to those required be made available.
- Advertisements and promotions regarding the screening camp are to be done by the organisers. The content to be printed/displayed should be done only after consultation with MVRCCRI.
